Notes on the Edition

Our goal at Noteworthy Sheet Music is to provide novel music transcriptions and historic scores of outstanding quality at reasonable cost. Musicians' concerns are of primary importance to us when we prepare parts, scores, and facsimiles. We strive for accuracy, clarity, and convenient formatting.

Robert Schumann (1810-1856) composed *Märchenbilder (Fairy Tale Pictures, Opus 113)* for viola and piano in 1851. The piece is alternately indicated for violin and piano, by the composer himself. In creating this transcription for alto flute, we have incorporated several changes from the previous versions to account for sonic differences between the alto flute and the viola or violin. In so doing, every effort has been made to maintain the spirit and character of the original composition.

We provide here the first movement of the alto flute part as a free sample of our work; the piano part is readily available in the public domain as a free pdf download of the score for viola and piano.
